Maybe you have ideas which need a superman to come true! Maybe you also have songs, poems, stories, drama, puppet plays or music which tells about water.

August, 24 in the afternoon, you will also get the opportunity to meet and dialogue with Mayors who have special interest in listening and learning from children. The dialogue will take place in the water landscapes and on the main stage.

Children's Water Way will be the kick off for the next Globetree event: The World Championship in Cooperation, May/June 2006. The Millennium Development Goals, The Rights of the Child and the Agenda 21 are the base of the Children Water Ways as well as of the World Championship in Cooperation. The goal is to find ways how to transform the contents into practical actions.
